Join The Tots-Nursery Team!

We're looking for a dedicated volunteer to join our team and serve on the 1st Sunday of each month in our children's ministry (January to May).

Our Tot-Nursery serves littles around the age of 1-3 y/o (sometimes earlier then 1 y/o, when they are old enough for drop off and

independent play).

Volunteers can arrange to swap Sundays if a month doesn't work out, but generally we have a rotation that we use and our vacancy is for the 1st Sunday of the month.

We text parents for diaper changes and have volunteers arrive at 9:45 and stay until about 11:15 once all the kids are picked up.

Note: We do a background check on all kid's ministry volunteers to ensure safety.
