Outreach Plan**

Our Ministry Coordinating Team evaluated the last years of doing Easter Eggstravaganza and its cost of people and finances to connect people to Christ and decided to NOT

do the even this year and redirect those resources to other outreach initiatives. Easter Eggstravaganza produced about 10-12 worship visitors. To seek equal connections to worship and ongoing ministry opportunities, we will encourage us all to focus on the following:

1. **Personal invitations** to family and friends – this is ALWAYS the most effective way of connecting people to Jesus.
2. **“Farming” our neighboring communities** – 5-6 times in 2025 to drop a flier/small gift at the neighbors next to church and in Berry Creek Highlands.
3. **New Mover** mailing through Outreach.com (Try for one year).

In addition, we are looking for a good place in our community to serve and rub shoulders with other Georgetown residents. We also are planning **movie nights** again for May through October as community come events.
