NURSERY – For parents with infants. Unstaffed nursery room is to the right of the entryway as you exit. You are able to watch and listen to worship.

 **TOTS** – For parents with children aged 1-2. Crosspoint Kids volunteer staff are happy to watch your child during worship. Tot care is in the Kids Church area.

PreK – For parents with children aged 3-4. Crosspoint Kids volunteer staff are happy to watch your child during worship. PreK Kids program is in the Kids Church area and includes a short worship time.

KIDS CHURCH – Kids Church is offered for kids K-3rd grade during the school year (September – May). Kids start in church and just before the sermon, shift to the kids space for worship on their level.



NEED #1: Nakesha (single mom) and Eli are getting set up in their new apartment. If you have any of these and could bring to church for them, they would greatly appreciate it!
