TEST:

A procedure for critical evaluation; a means of determining the presence, quality, or <u>truth</u> of something; a trial.

A series of questions, problems, or physical responses designed to determine knowledge, intelligence, or ability.

Why did Jesus do miracles?

John 20:30 Jesus did many other miraculous signs in the presence of his disciples, which are not recorded in this book. 31 But <u>these</u> <u>are written</u> that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name.

A test question: (John 6:1-6)

6 Some time after this, Jesus crossed to the far shore of the Sea of Galilee (that is, the Sea of Tiberias), 2 and a great crowd of people followed him because they saw the miraculous signs he had performed on the sick. 3 Then Jesus went up on a mountainside and sat down with his disciples. 4 The Jewish Passover Feast was near.

5 When Jesus looked up and saw a great crowd coming toward him, he said to Philip, "Where shall we buy bread for these people to eat?" 6 <u>He</u> <u>asked this only to test him</u>, for he already had in mind what he was going to do.

7 Philip answered him, "Eight months' wages would not buy enough bread for each one to have a bite!"

8 Another of his disciples, Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, spoke up, 9 "Here is a boy with five small barley loaves and two small fish, but how far will they go among so many?"

 - 2 Corinthians 1:8-9 We were under great pressure, far beyond our ability to endure, so that we despaired even of life. ⁹ Indeed, in our hearts we felt the sentence of death. But this happened that we might not rely on ourselves but on God, who raises the dead.
- 2. The ______ we have to give is not always ______
 - 2 Corinthians 3:4 Such confidence as this is ours through Christ before God. 5 Not that we are competent in ourselves to claim anything for ourselves, but our competence comes from God.

Jesus' answer: (John 6:10-13)

10 Jesus said, "Have the people sit down." There was plenty of grass in that place, and the men sat down, about five thousand of them. 11 Jesus then took the loaves, gave thanks, and distributed to those who were seated as much as they wanted. He did the same with the fish.

12 When they had all had enough to eat, he said to his disciples, "Gather the pieces that are left over. Let nothing be wasted." 13 So they gathered them and filled twelve baskets with the pieces of the five barley loaves left over by those who had eaten.

People's reaction: (John 6:14-15)

14 After the people saw the miraculous sign that Jesus did, they began to say, "Surely this is the Prophet who is to come into the world." 15 Jesus, knowing that they intended to come and make him king by force, withdrew again to a mountain by himself.

If anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever. This bread is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world."
