Mark 1:21 They went to Capernaum, and when the Sabbath came, Jesus went into the synagogue and began to teach. 22 The people were amazed at his teaching, because he taught them as one who had authority, not as the teachers of the law. 23 Just then a man in their synagogue who was possessed by an evil spirit cried out, 24 "What do you want with us, Jesus of Nazareth? - John 5:39-40 You diligently study the Scriptures because you think that by them you possess eternal life. These are the Scriptures that testify about me, 40 yet you refuse to come to me to have life.

- Psalm 119: 97 Oh, how I love your law! I meditate on it all day long. 98 Your commands make me wiser than my enemies, for they are ever with me. 99 I have more insight than all my teachers, for I meditate on your statutes. 100 I have more understanding than the elders, for I obey your precepts.
- Luke 24:44 He said to them, "This is what I told you while I was still
 with you: Everything must be fulfilled that is written about me in the
 Law of Moses, the Prophets and the Psalms." 45 Then he opened their
 minds so they could understand the Scriptures.
- Proverbs 2:1ff My son, if you accept my words and store up my commands within you, turning your ear to wisdom and applying your heart to understanding, ... ⁶ For the LORD gives wisdom, and from his mouth come knowledge and understanding. ... Then you will understand what is right and just and fair—every good path. ¹⁰For wisdom will enter your heart, and knowledge will be pleasant to your soul. ¹¹Discretion will protect you, and understanding will quard you.

- a. Jesus has power over _____!
 - Matthew 4:10-11 Jesus said to him, "Away from me, Satan! For it is written: 'Worship the Lord your God, and serve him only.'" 11 Then the devil left him, and angels came and attended him.
 - 1 John 3:8 He who does what is sinful is of the devil, because the devil has been sinning from the beginning. The reason the Son of God appeared was to destroy the devil's work.

b. We have power over _____!

- 1 Corinthians 10:13 No temptation has seized you except what is common to man. And God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can stand up under it.
- 1 Peter 5:8 Be self-controlled and alert. Your enemy the devil prowls
 around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour. 9 Resist him,
 standing firm in the faith, because you know that your brothers
 throughout the world are undergoing the same kind of sufferings.
