Shadows: A Glimpse of a Snake!

Colossians 2:17 <u>These are a shadow</u> of the things that were to come; <u>the reality</u>, however, <u>is found in Christ</u>.

What is your reaction to a snake?

Numbers 21:4 They traveled from Mount Hor along the route to the Red Sea, to go around Edom. But **the people grew impatient** on the way; 5 they spoke against God and against Moses, and said, "Why have you brought us up out of Egypt to die in the desert? There is no bread! There is no water! And we detest this miserable food!"

6 Then the **LORD sent venomous snakes among them**; they bit the people and many Israelites died. 7 The people came to Moses and said, "We sinned when we spoke against the LORD and against you. Pray that the LORD will take the snakes away from us." So Moses prayed for the people.

8 The LORD said to Moses, **"Make a snake and put it up on a pole; anyone who** *is bitten can look at it and live."* 9 So Moses made a bronze snake and put it up on a pole. Then when anyone was bitten by a snake and looked at the bronze snake, he lived.

- Colossians 3:11 Clearly no one is justified before God by the law, because, "The righteous will live by faith." 12 The law is not based on faith; on the contrary, "The man who does these things will live by them." 13 Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us, for it is written: "Cursed is everyone who is hung on a tree."
