Dads, never underestimate the ______ you are to your children!

- Here are a few ways that God designed dads to have a unique influence on their families:
 - A father's strength can be powerful
 - A dad's words can be fueling and inspirational
 - Hugs from a dad can be deeply comforting
 - A dad's smiles can instill joy and confidence
 - o Time with a dad can be fun and productive
 - A dad's physicality can be challenging
 - A dad's quidance can be life-changing and foundational
 - A father's correction can be life-saving and life-giving
 - Adventures with a dad can be exciting and memorable¹
- According to the Father Involvement Research Alliance review, girls with involved fathers have higher self-esteem, and teenage girls who are close to their dads are less likely to become pregnant. Boys show less aggression, less impulsivity, and

more self-direction. As young adults, children of involved fathers are more likely to achieve higher levels of education, find success in their careers, have higher levels of self-acceptance and experience psychological well-being. Adults who had involved fathers are more likely to be tolerant and understanding, have supportive social networks made up of close friends, and have long-term successful marriages.²

Another survey found that if a child is the first person in a household to become a
 Christian, there is a 3.5% probability everyone else in the household will follow. If
 the mother is the first to become a Christian, there is a 17% probability everyone
 else in the household will follow. However, when the father is first, there is a
 ______% probability everyone else in the household will follow. 3
